Registration Options Following Learn To Skate 3-night sessions**

LTS Season 1 (Nov/Dec) \$59

LTS Season 2 (Jan/Feb) \$59

LTS Season 1 & 2 (Nov - Feb) \$118

New Mite (includes participation in Mite Jamborees) \$129

*All skaters who have only participated in LTS sessions are considered New (Beginner) Mites.

****USA Hockey Registration is required. No fee is required for registration with USA Hockey for players 6 years and younger (birth year 2011 or later). Children older than 6 years will be required to pay a registration fee of \$40 with USA Hockey. Please visit <https://usahockeyregistration.com/> to complete registration. You will receive a USA Hockey number which you will need for completing paperwork to register for normal season sessions of Learn to Skate.**

How long is the Mite season?

For New Mites, the season starts with the Placement and Parent Meeting, Oct. 24, 2017. The season runs between Nov. 1 and March 1. Beginner Mites, Intermediate and Advanced Mites can expect 30 practices during the season. All practices are voluntary. Your child will benefit from maximum ice time, but there is no penalty for missed practices.

In addition to practices, all mite levels will participate in three to five Hockey Jamborees, including the home jamboree.

Pending Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association (WAHA) approval and tournament availability, an away tournament may be added to the schedule.

Can my LTS Session 1 (Nov/Dec) skater move up to Mite during this time (or after December)?

Yes. You will have the option to move to Mite status after the beginning of the season. Fees will be prorated and your player will be eligible to participate in Jamborees at that time. Practice times for Learn to Skate and Beginner Mites are the same time and for the same duration.

Are there additional obligations?

Any Learn To Skate family who registers for either the Nov/Dec or Jan/Feb short seasons (or both) will not be required to complete service hours but will participate in the fundraising requirement at a reduced level, \$100 (five Dick's Raffle tickets for the 2017-2018 season). *Obligation remains the same for LTS families regardless of possible mid-season transfer to mite program.*

How do I register my skater?

During your 3-day session in October, should you choose to register:

Step 1: visit <http://www.tornadoyouthhockey.org/registration/> and register your skater (LTS 1 and LTS 2 options will be added Oct. 1).

Step 2: visit the registration table at the Omni Center Oct. 4 (6-7 p.m.) or 5 (6-7 p.m.) to complete your registration. Bring your "Season 2017/18 Registration Packet" printed during the online registration process.

Step 3 (only if you register as a New Mite): attend the New Mite Placement Night (skaters) and New Mite Parent Meeting, Oct. 24, 2017, 5:30 - 6:30 p.m. (Omni Center).
